 - o If we decide to sell and they don't like who we are selling to than they get first right of refusal and if we do sell then we pay back the grant money to the town. But, if we transfer it to someone they like, such as SSI, then they will not ask for the money back.
 - Jeremy has the copies of papers from Caroline that explains all of this. Caroline said the Gakyil approved all of it. Yellow thinks we should go forward as long as restrictions aren't too hard.

Fall Programming

- After the summer retreat, the Gakyil will have a meeting and decide the fall programming and implement it. There is a lot of interest in SMS but there is difficulty organizing the SMS teachers. Email brainstorming will be done for this. It will be good to get the programming through 2017 in place for the new Gakyil. Thankfully, Lynn Newdome will do an SMS Base program in the fall.
- We can engage Steve Landsberg again. He requires 8 people minimum for workshops. We can ask Michael Katz. Miranda Shannon would like to help set this up.

International Teachers

- Two teachers coming: Prima Mai and Laura Evangelisti. Blue needs help with pricing retreats. International teachers have a fixed price for the day. \$125/day? Something around that. International teachers cost around \$5,000 once a retreat is all said and done, maybe more. Prima is teaching for a while. We are seeing if she can stay in the Buckland Woods.
- → Blue just learned that supervision courses are open to the public or beginners. The people being supervised, according to Naomi Zeitz, do not pay. The people attending pay for the course. Blue wants to write a newsletter breaking down the courses and who it's available to in terms of beginners or advanced etc. Laura will supervise 6 or 7 people and Prima will supervise 3 or 4.

ACTION ITEM: Ask IG for standardized pricing for international teachers. The Gakyil is thinking \$210 USD for 5 day retreats

- Any additional ideas for how to raise money? Michael Katz did the Rinpoche photo auction last year that brought in a lot of money. Jeremy has an idea of selling photos of Khandroling. We can do a raffle for a week in DZ or something like that also.
- There are 12 people preregistered at this point. There need to be more notices sent out. Even with low numbers we should keep it going but we wouldn't spend the same money in expenses. Even if there are 20 people we can still do it and have a wonderful week.
 - o If there are less than 30 lunch orders then people will be told to bring their own lunches.

Visiting International Teachers Update from Adriane Boscardin

- → Adriane Boscardin, Naomi Zeitz, Curzio Aloisi and Paula Barry are coordinating Laura Evangelisti. Ed Hayes is coordinating for Prima Mai. Teacher care has been discussed. There will need to be yoga mats, pillows and water up at the Vajra Hall. It's pretty basic.
- ↓ Laura will mostly stay in Rinpoche's Cabin but there is a night or two in NY. Kunsangar and Merigar are purchasing transportation tickets and then DCA will reimburse them. DCA reimburses Kunsangar for Laura and Merigar for Prima.
- Laura wants to stay on the land for retreat. When she arrives she'll stay one night in NY and when she leaves also. When she arrives she will stay with Curzio or someone else. Does she need car, rental, phone, grocery etc? We need to think about her needs when she's on the land. Laura is gluten free. All receipts will be collected and given to Tim. A good excel sheet will be helpful to know who is in charge of what task.

Financial Items

- ↓ If no fundraising occurs than there will only be about \$15,000 going into 2018. We have \$4,400 in DZ account that will go toward loans and expenses. Diane would like to see a bill for expenses. Kyu (DZ TE House Geko) used the DZ money to pay the expenses. The next bill will come in September for February-September. DCA has \$16,000 from Joan Casey and \$20,000 in Money Market. The Khandroling account has about \$10,000.
- → DCA is spending too much for bookkeeping, accounting and data entry. Yellow thinks it could be reduced by about \$8,000 per year. DCA pays for about \$20,000 in repairs each year. Perhaps this can be cut in half and then Yellow can fundraise for the rest of the ongoing repairs.
