# **Savings from KPI**

→ Diane Sievers found a cheaper KPI board insurance. Diane Sievers and Paula Gould found a policy that was half the price for KPI board insurance. The entire cost of KPI is now down from \$16,500 to approximately \$13,000.

# DCA is no longer getting \$1,500 Rent from SSI

- Will Shea (SSI Board Treasurer) says SSI can pay \$500/month. The reason is that Kunye license has not been approved and they were planning to emphasize this program for income. Maybe DCA will have a board meeting with them. How else can SSI generate income?
- SSI should have more programs and maybe DCA can assist in incorporating SSI into the DCA programming to help them out.
