### **IDC Alignment**

- → DCA is at the point where David (attorney) and Mark Farrington have approved the documents. First we are going to upload the documents for members to read. Only paid Members of Tsegyalgar East can read. Then, the Community is going to vote.
- The voting system: The vote will be at an upcoming Ganapuja because there are around 30-40 people there. There has to be 70% agreement to pass (That is currently 166 of our Members). Members can who cannot be physically present can appoint a local proxy for themselves. Proxy's can deliver up to 9 votes. The final day to vote will be October 27th; it's a Ganapuja day. Oliver Leick will be here. DCA will webcast the Ganapuja with a ticker tape that says 'stay tuned for Community Vote after Ganapuja.'
- → All 236 members have to vote. The Secretary will have to track certain people who have not submitted a vote.
- The current Gakyil has to sign a protocol with the IDC on alignment. This protocol is not only signed by the current Gakyil but also by every coming Gakyil. Every Gakyil will re-sign the agreement with the IDC. In order to change the bylaws, a Gakyil will have to go through the same process that this Gakyil went through. There are more paragraphs in the bylaws than there were in the 80's and our principles have changed and so the bylaws are slightly different.

## **Gakyil Transition**

- Our new official Secretary of the Gakyil will be Dominik.
- ♣ Next phase is another call for Gakyil candidates. Maybe Yulia from Canada will join Blue Gakyil.
- An announcement that includes a Membership drive, letting everyone knows that they need to be a member to vote will be sent out.. Tsegyalgar East can webcast it and Members can vote.
- For future Blue: this Gakyil committed to scheduling 4 community meetings a year. It depends on the circumstances if subsequent Gakyil's feels that it's necessary or not. By IDC standards, we need at least one General Assembly per year. Massachusetts also requires that there is a minimum of one. 1-2 per year is good. At least one is required to shift the admin positions.
- ☐ IG asks distant Gakyil Members to come to the Gar 4 times per year. Emails create much confusion but in person collaboration is much easier. Nothing replaces a person's presence.

## **Programming**

- ♣ Lynn Newdome is creating a new SMS Base course.
- ♣ DCA/SSI should have 3 open houses a year, at least 2, seasonally. ASIA should be involved too.
- Monday, Ed and Sarale are giving public talks for their Teacher Training for the Vajra Dance.

#### **Schoolhouse Roof**

- ← Caroline forwarded an email from the Historical Commission which included a model agreement
  of what provisions this should include. As Ed Methany understands it, the main reservation
  that's been expressed locally is based on the experience of the UCC which got damaged and ran
  into problems with the town when trying to repair it.
- The Gakyil is waiting on whatever the town will draft as an agreement. Anything that comes from the town should go to the Gakyil at this point, not to Caroline.
- ♣ Work on the roof should occur before the winter. Ed thinks it's important that the community is okay with the agreement, though. Anyone that's expressed a concern about the restrictions should be put at ease. DCA does not necessarily need a lawyer. It's a matter of whether or not we have a consensus going forward about the agreement. Community Members who are lawyers will be consulted: Diane Sievers, Ed Methany, and Fred Klarer.
- ♣ The outside of the Schoolhouse has to preserve the historical features that make it of value. The agreement will pass to any future owners as well.
- \$10-12,000 more dollars to put snow guards on new schoolhouse roof. Entire project will take 2 weeks or so

## **Financial Picture**

- Fundraising is keeping the bank balance stable for now. There's \$54,000 in operating monies. In the last month or two this has stabilized. We have to see if we can keep the donations coming in. If no donations come in then the reserves dip about 6-7,000/month..

- ↓ Vajra Dance and Yantra Yoga teachers are meeting with senior teachers to develop public information There's a collaborative effort to create information to provide to the general public.
- ♣ People will be working to figure out the best place to leave these information bits.

## Tsegyalgar East Becoming the Center for International Vajra Dance.

- The Gakyil should start up this discussion. How to build the VD in American; then present to Rinpoche. Rinpoche has to approve this himself. The Gakyil will also ask for Prima Mai's input.
- ➡ Tsegyaglar East could develop mandalas in every major city in the country. Developing
  Khandroling further is another option. We can also talk with Adriana. The local teachers should
  be involved in this discussion as well. Ed Hayes, Carisa O'Kelly, Bodhi Krause etc.
- ↓ Ways to develop Vajra Dance in the U.S. Use both the Solar Mandala and the Universal Mandala. A fund is proposed for Vajra Dance teachers so they can more easily travel. Perhaps there could be a Vajra Dance magazine. There could also be ads related to this. TE needs to build and get to the point of being the true center of the Vajra Dance for this to work.
